




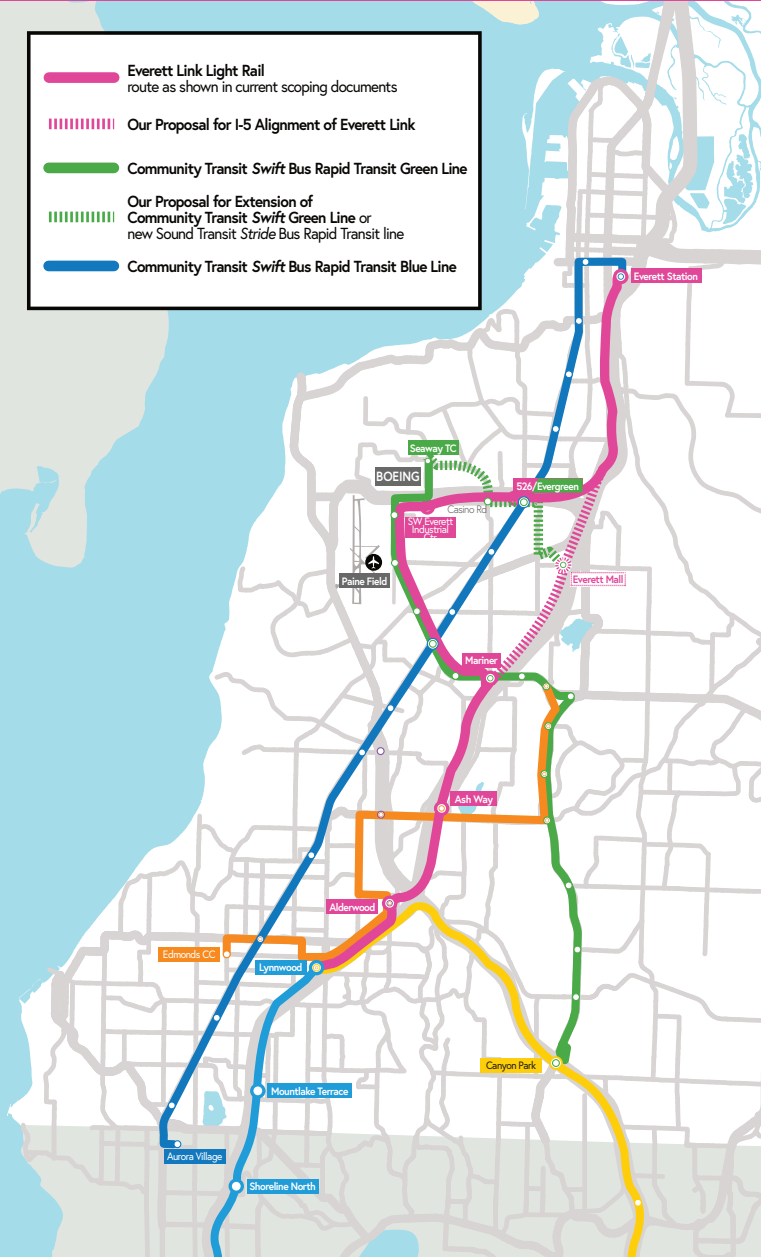


What transit is right for Casino Road?

Over the next 15 years, Sound Transit will build a transit rail line from Lynnwood to Downtown Everett.

The new transit line would be built through the Casino Road neighborhood, with stations near Evergreen Way and near Airport Road.

The new transit line could make getting to Lynnwood and Seattle faster. It could also eliminate existing low-rent apartments in the neighborhood in order to build the lane, and by causing more expensive housing to get built.

That's why Connect Casino Road wants to hear what you want.
